

# Lake City Figure Skating Guest Coaching Policy

---

The Lake City Figure Skating programs and Freestyle sessions at Frontier Ice Arena are operated by Spokane Figure Skating Club (SFSC), for the benefit of SFSC's Basic Skills and U.S. Figure Skating members.

Coaches and their students belonging to other U.S. Figure Skating member clubs may be granted permission to participate in Lake City Figure Skating Freestyle sessions by completing this form and adhering to the following Guest Coaching Policy.

Note that SFSC by-laws require members of other clubs to become "second club" members of SFSC to participate on club ice. However SFSC will waive that requirement through August 31, 2014.

All Guest coaches must have current U.S. Figure Skating and PSA credentials.

All Guest coaches and students must pay admission fee to skate or coach on Freestyle sessions. Guest coaches may not teach on public sessions.

Guest coaches may not, at any time, solicit skaters of the Lake City Figure Skating *Learn to Skate* programs, students of another coach, or persons on public sessions.

All coaches must adhere to the PSA Code of Ethics. Coaches must not interfere physically, verbally or in any other manner with other coaches or students during their lessons.

Guest coaches are responsible for the safe and respectful conduct of their students on sessions hosted by Lake City Figure Skating.

Lake City Figure Skating / Spokane Figure Skating Club may deny Guest Coaching privileges at any time.

If a Guest coach does not follow the foregoing rules and regulations, they will be asked to leave immediately and will not be allowed to return to the rink.
